

Monster Beanie

Materials:

1 skein each of Red Heart Super Saver in Black, Pumpkin, and White
1 skein Red Heart Reflective Yarn in Neon Yellow
Fiberfill
Crochet hook H
Darning needle
Place marker

Abbreviations/terms:

mc = magic circle
ch = chain
dc = double crochet
hdc = half double crochet
sc = single crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)

Gauge: 14 dc = 4 inches
8 dc rows = 4 inches



Beanie

Using Black, mc, ch 2, 9 dc in mc, join to first dc, ch 2
Round 2: 2 dc in each st around, join to first dc, ch 2 = 18 dc
Round 3: 2 dc in first st, dc in next st, repeat around, join to first dc, ch 2 = 27 dc
Round 4: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 2 sts, repeat around, join to first dc, ch 2 = 36 dc
Round 5: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 3 sts, repeat around, join to first dc, ch 2 = 45 dc
Round 6: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 4 sts, repeat around, join to first dc, ch 2 = 54 dc
Round 7: dc around = 54 dc
Round 8: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 8 sts, repeat around, join to first dc, ch 2 = 60 dc
Round 9: 2 dc in first st, dc in next 29 sts, repeat around, join to first dc, ch 2 = 62 dc
Rounds 10 – 14: dc around = 62 dc



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Curvy monster horns (make 3, reverse colors on one)

Round 1: With black, Mc, 3 sc, pm
Round 2: 2 sc in each st around = 6 sc
Round 3: sc around = 6 sc
Round 4: *2 sc in first st, sc in next st* around = 9 sc
Round 5: sc around = 9 sc
Round 6: *2sc in first st, sc in next 2 sts* around = 12 sc
Round 7: change to pumpkin, sc around = 12 sc
Round 8: *2 sc in first st, sc in next 3 sts* = 15 sc

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Round 9: sc around = 15 sc

Round 10: change to black, sc, 2 sc in each st 4 times, sc in next st, dec 1 st 4 times, sc in last st = 15 sc

Rounds 11 & 12: sc around = 15 sc

Round 13: sc, dec 1 st 4 times, sc, 2 sc in each st 4 times, sc = 15 sc

Round 14: change to pumpkin, sc around = 15 sc

Rounds 15 - 17: sc around = 15 sc

Round 18: keeping the pumpkin color, repeat round 10 = 15 sc

Round 19: change to black, sc around = 15 sc

Round 20: sc around

Round 21: sc around, end off, **leaving a long length of yarn for sewing in place later on**. Stuff with either fiberfill or yarn to shape.

Glowing eyes

I used Redheart's reflective yarn in neon yellow

Round 1: Ch 6, sc in 2nd ch from hook and to last ch, 3 sc in last ch, turn and sc on opposite side of ch loops to end, 2 sc in last ch = 12 sc

Round 2: 2 sc in first st, sc in next 4 sts, 2 st in next st twice, sc in next 4 sts, 3 sc in last st = 17 sc

Round 3: 3 sc in first st, sc in next 6 sts, 3 sc in next st twice, sc to end, sl st to first sc, end off, **leaving a long length of yarn for sewing in place later on** = 23 sc

Pupils: ch 5, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and across, end off, **leaving a long length of yarn for sewing in place later on** = 4 sts

Eyelids (optional): with black, ch 10, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc for next 5 sts, sc next 2 sts, sl st last st, end off, leaving a long tail for sewing. Put these on after the eyes have been attached to the beanie.

Teeth: with white, join anywhere on the bottom round of the cap, *ch 4, sc in 2nd ch from hook, hdc in next ch, dc in last ch, sk next two sts, sl st in 3rd st* and repeat around. You will be short one st at the very end, but it's not noticeable.
